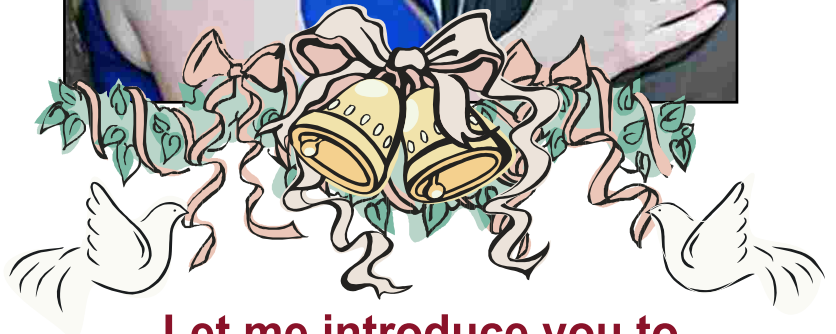
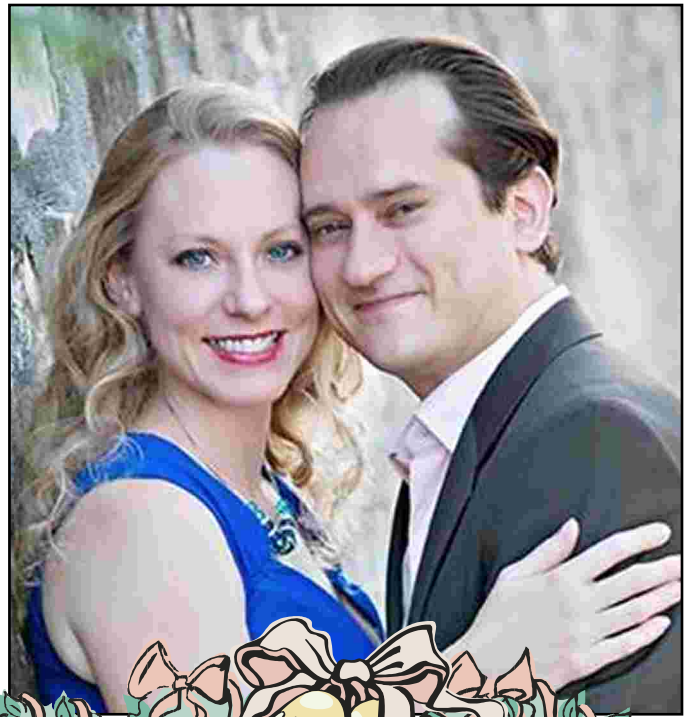
Hey you FF Society guys and gals.
