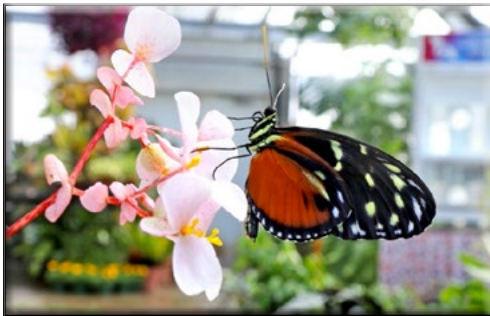


Holiday Greetings (continued from page 2)

Dow Gardens – Traverse City Pie Company

Thursday, June 9th, 2022

This morning we depart Bay City 9:15 AM and head to Midland to visit the award winning Dow Gardens where we enjoy a guided tour. Enjoy the magnificent colors of the season where there are over 100 acres of flowers, shrubs, ponds and trees in a relaxing pastoral setting. Follow the paved curving paths as you meander past a waterfall, beside a winding brook and over bridges. Be sure not to miss the Conservatory with lush tropical orchids and seasonal displays. You may even find the young-at-heart exploring a tree house.

We then take the short drive (or you can walk) to the visitor center located at the former Whiting Forest. Guests of all ages and abilities will become immersed in the forest on the longest canopy walk in America. The canopy walk stretches 1,400 feet long (just over ¼ mile) and soars 40 feet above the lush forest and apple orchard.

It's then time to head to a Michigan favorite for lunch at the Grand Traverse Pie Company. Make yourself at home in the warm and welcoming atmosphere as you enjoy a full deli sandwich, chips, beverage, and of course a slice of pie!

The planetarium is certainly one of the most unique and significant buildings in downtown Bay City and has won significant awards from the American Institute of Architects!

Upon arrival in the theatre you will learn many more facts on the design and architectural elements before the main event entitled *From Earth to the Universe*. An immersive grand tour of the universe, this show starts with the splendor of the various worlds in the solar system and the ferocity of the scorching Sun. The program then leaves our home to take the audience out to the colorful birthplaces and burial grounds of stars, and still further out, beyond the Milky Way, to the unimaginable immensity of countless galaxies. Along the way, you will learn about famous astronomers, the invention of the telescope, and today's giant telescopes that allow us to probe ever deeper into the Universe.

After the amazing show you will have a box lunch provided at approximately 11:30 AM
