Directions: The hotel is located on the south east end of town close to the airport, shopping and many restaurants
By Air: Once you arrive at Gerald R. Ford International Airport in Grand Rapids, proceed to the baggage claim area
and use the Crowne Plaza phone to call hotel for pick up. This is a no charge service. Hotel is less than 10 minutes
away from airport.

<u>By Car</u>: From the east- take I 96 and get off at exit 43B and head _ mile east. From the south/west- take I 196 past downtown and it mergers into I 96 and then exit at 43 B — head _ mile east

- Drive Time: Chicago 3 hours, Detroit 2 _, Indianapolis 4 _, Cleveland 5, Pittsburgh 7, Cincinnati 6 _, Nashville 8, Milwaukee 4 _, Louisville 6,
- **Hotel:** The convention hotel is Crowne Plaza, 5700 28th St SE, Phone 616 957 1770 (888-957-9575). If you have not made you hotel registration yet, I would encourage you to do so soon.
