"ROAD SHOW...from Purdue University...with June Christy, the Four Freshmen, and the Stan Kenton Orchestra." Interestingly enough, the next stop after that incredible October 10, 1959, recording session was Vets Memorial in Columbus, Ohio.

Now, 48 years later, that magic night was recreated at the acoustically perfect Southern Theater in downtown Columbus. This time with the lovely Kelly Crum Delavaris doing the Christy songs, the one and only Four Freshmen themselves, and the Columbus Jazz Orchestra doing Stan. In case you didn't know, the CJO is as close as you can get to the Kenton sound.

In addition to the Road Show tunes, our Freshmen, twice, gave the band a break while harmonizing unplugged. You really get to appreciate the group's talent when they sing like this. You get to hear some older album material that you might not have ever heard in person. And they blew us out of our seats with "Goodbye" from the Five Trumpets album.

The Freshmen sale table was quite busy before the show and during the break. I had numerous requests for the original Road Show album which seems to be unavailable anymore. (Maybe that might be a good project for the FFS to market.)

When the CJO does its Stan Kenton tribute, they bring back director emeritus Ray Eubanks who incited this annual occurrence some years ago. Following intermission, Ray introduced the 2007 Hank Marr High School Jazz Award recipient, Jeff Benatar. Now, let me tell you, friends, this high school senior came out on stage, took a bow, sat down at the piano and attacked that keyboard Kenton style and the band roared into an "Intermission Riff" that rattled the chandeliers. Wow! Too bad this event wasn't recorded - it would have been a CD to die for.
