The Lynden Music Festival Celebrates The Four Freshmen!

ALL Four Freshmen Society Members, families, and friends are enthusiastically invited to attend a big FF Society "Gathering" on October 9-13, 2024 in Lynden, Washington. The event will be in conjunction with *The Lynden Music Festival's* 15th Anniversary and it will be similar to the Society's past "Conventions," but it will be less expensive, and it will offer à la carte opportunities! LyndenMusicFestival.com will be continuously updating details of this 5-day event! There may not be any Wannabees or 113 Club, but there will be The Four Freshmen, a jam, and lots of fall fun in Washington!





How will we get to Lynden?

You can drive to Lynden or fly directly into BLI (Bellingham International Airport) from hubs such as Las Vegas, Oakland, Long Beach, Palm Springs, Phoenix/Mesa, Denver, and Seattle, then take a *LYFT* or cab to one of two main hotels in Lynden, a 30-minute ride. If the *Lynden Music Festival* knows your arrival time, they may send a shuttle to gather you! When you make reservations, let hotels know you are a FFS Member, and you will enjoy a discount on your lodging!

Where will we stay? The *Inn At Lynden* is the "official" hotel; the *Freshmen* will be staying there, and they will give Society Members a 20% discount if you ask. As they have less than 40 rooms available, a brand new hotel nearby, *The Cobblestone Hotel*, will be happy to accommodate additional Society Members with a 15% discount. Their website is: staycobblestone.com/wa/lynden. The *Holiday Inn* at the BLI is also a possibility; it is a 5-minute walk across the Bellingham Airport parking lot where you could stay any number of nights from October 8-14 for only \$129 per night! Their number is (360) 746-6844.

Do you have a camper or RV? You might consider driving it to Lynden and hooking into a space at the Lynden Fairgrounds for only \$30 per night! You will be near the WECU Center for the Thursday "Dance Night," and the *Four Freshmen* concerts on Friday and Saturday! Make reservations for your RV space at: lyndenmusicfestival@gmail.com or call (909) 936-1057.





What will we do while we are in Lynden? In addition to attending any or all of the musical offerings during your visit, you can stroll the charming Front Street of Lynden, snack at *Avenue Bread*, the *Dutch Bakery*, or the *Eucatastrophe Coffee Shop*, dine at restaurants featuring Mexican, Greek, Italian, and Asian cuisine, visit the *Lynden Heritage Museum* (one of the best in the state), pop up to see the historic *Peace Arch* in Blaine, journey over to Mt. Baker, head down to Bellingham for a whale watching cruise through the San Juan Islands, or play a round of golf at one of the many nearby courses. If you bring your passport, you can even slip across the border into Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada, or take the beautiful Tsawwassen Ferry to the historic city of Victoria, B.C. on Vancouver Island! New adventures lurk everywhere during your visit!

The Four Freshmen will hold a student workshop on Thursday, October 10, and will then perform two uniquely different concerts, one on Friday with a local "big band," The *Swing Connection*, and one on Saturday, with a buffet dinner preceding the concert! Again, there is a "Society" jam session Friday afternoon at the *Jansen Arts Center*, so bring your axe!

There is NO registration fee for this Gathering, but please go to the *Four Freshmen Society* website and click the *FFS Gatherings* tab to let Chaz know when you're arriving and where you will be staying. A member of the *Lynden Music Festival Committee* will greet you with a FREE Goody Bag full of visitor information, fun, and surprises when you arrive!



Here's an idea, especially if you have never visited the "Fourth Corner" of the USA before now! Tuesdays are notoriously "light" travel days, so, arrive on Tuesday, October 8 and stay until Tuesday October 15! Make it a Full Fall Four Freshmen Fling with family and friends! The East Coast does not hold a candle to the autumn beauty of the Pacific Northwest, with evergreens speckled among fall's yellow, orange and red leaves! Lynden Music Festival President, David Jewkes!

David Jewkes is the President of the Lynden Music Festival, which is a tax exempt, 501(c)(3) organization in Washington State. He has always had a passion for music, having played the piano since age four, the accordion since age nine, and the pipe organ since the age of 16. He has also sung in choirs since age six.

David earned a B.A. in Mathematics from Walla Walla College in 1974, a Masters from Loma Linda University, and then he went on to pursue a career in teaching which lasted 46 years, five of which were as a school administrator.

He retired to the beautiful area of Lynden, Washington in 2021 and became totally immersed in its music community. He is looking forward to welcoming The Four Freshmen to the Lynden Music Festival this October! Oh, when not pursuing his musical endeavors, David enjoys sailing, photography, and automobiles! (There is never a dull moment!)

Lynden Music Festival Organizing Chairmen, Terhi Miikki-Broersma and Doug Broersma!

Terhi Miikki-Broersma is Executive Director of the Lynden Music Festival. A native of Finland, she has been a church musician since she was 14, and after graduating in 1993 she earned a Masters of Music degree from the Sibelius Academy in Helsinki. She worked for 10 years as a cantor-organist in a Lutheran Church in Kotka, Finland, and then for 8 months in Benalmadena, Spain before moving to the United States.

She is proficient on piano, accordion, bassoon, and pipe organ, and she currently conducts the Emmaus Lutheran Church Choir in Vancouver, British Columbia and the Suomi Conference Choir. She was named Performer of Year in 2009

by the Finlandia National Foundation, and she is often called upon to travel to different areas of the United States to perform at numerous Finnish and Scandinavian church and community celebrations.

Terhi is always "at the ready" to help musicians who are in need of an accompanist or a musical collaborator, and her talent, organizational skills, and boundless energy have made the annual Lynden Music Festival the success that it is today!

Doug Broersma is a lifelong Lynden resident, graduating high school in 1975 and then establishing his own building maintenance company. He is a well-known and highly respected member of the Lynden community.

When he wasn't fixing or cleaning something, Doug was following his love for a cappella music. He started singing in barbershop quartets in 1971 and soon became involved at the competition level.

Doug became the director for the Mount Baker Toppers Barbershop Chorus in the 1990s and maintained that position for 20 years. He was also chosen as the replacement Lead singer for the 2005 International Champion Barbershop Quartet, *Realtime*.

While performing on a music tour at a festival in Finland, Doug met his future wife, Terhi Miikki-Broersma, who later moved to the United States. Doug and Terhi are in their 15th year of collaborating to make the annual LMF a joyful celebration of all kinds of music, from classical, to folk, to jazz.

Broersma has been strongly influenced by the unique vocal harmonies of The Four Freshmen. "They are my heroes," he says. "Lynden is so lucky to have them this year to headline our festival!"
