Homer and Jethro were the best, I think - they were Honest Fans. I saw them in Pomona - they were on the bill with Tennessee Ernie when I was at Capitol 1965. Ross had asked me to tell them "Hello," so they sat me in the 1st row. The first thing they did was one of their big hits, and in the first two choruses of it they did (actual count) excerpts of TEN FF records - 2 to 4 bars at a time! Incredible!
